Dear Eric,

Many thanks again for coming to the ASC Curriculum Committee last Friday and answering questions about the proposed BA in World Politics and the BS in Political Science.

The ASCC unanimously approved the two programs with the following contingencies:

- For the BS in Political Science: Please add program learning goals that are unique to the BS (distinguish it from the BA in Political Science).
- For both the BS in Political Science and the BA in World Politics: The pre-Political Science courses that students need to choose from (prerequisite to major) all carry GE Social Science status. Therefore, the four-year sample plans do not need two more GE Social Science courses. One of these should be replaced by an elective course.

I will return both programs via curriculum.osu.edu in a minute to enable the department to address the points above.
