Tim,

On Friday, February 7, the Arts and Humanities Panel reviewed the proposal to create a BS in Music.

During this first review, the Panel did not take a vote. A number of necessary documents were noticed to be missing and there also was a discussion about GE requirements for BS students. I here provide the feedback of the Panel:

- Curriculum map needs to be included.
- Include sample 4-year student plan.
- Panel would like more detailed explanation of what Sonic Arts is. Request to explain how the three ELOs for this track will be fulfilled. (This may be clarified when the Panel sees the curriculum map for the major with the 3 tracks.)
- Strengthen the major assessment plan in proposal. Please consult ASC Curriculum and Assessment Operations Manual (pp. 60-61): https://asccas.osu.edu/sites/asccas.osu.edu/files/ASC_CurrAssess_Operations_Manual.pdf
- Advising sheet:
 - o Arts College 1000 no longer exists. It should be replaced by ASC 1100.11.
 - Use VPA instead of "Arts" since it creates the impression that only an "Arts" course will be accepted to fulfill this GE slot. The Panel assumes it is not the case.
 - GE Mathematical and Logical Analysis course should be Math 1151 (or equivalent)—
 a requirement for BS. It is not clear whether Engineering Calculus 1 is appropriate
 for the degree.
 - o In a BS, the data analysis requirement is not part of the GE requirements. It needs to be one or several specific classes included *in the major*.
 - Everywhere that CSE is indicated in parentheses should probably say CS (for "Computer Science" track).
 - BS students need to have 2 labs (one for the GE Biological Science and one for GE Physical Science).
 - University-approved GE requirements say that ideally 3 courses should be taken in GE Natural Science. Why 1-5 and 1-5 for the 2 slots listed on the advising?
 - At least one course must be Historical Study. Therefore, one of the two lines that say "Cultures & Ideas OR Historical Study" needs to be replaced by "Historical Study."
 - Social Science category A&B: the wording implies that perhaps students need to take courses in the first two GE Social Science sub-categories as they appear on ASC GE advising sheets (i.e., Individuals and Groups & Organizations and Polities).
 Prefer a footnote that specifies that courses need to be from two of three GE Social Science sub-categories.
 - Slots for diversity: Might be best to explain that, if there is no overlap with another

GE category, Social Diversity in U.S. will correspond to one course and Global Studies will be two courses.

- Music 2240-41: these courses are not approved GE Global Studies courses. Are you
 requesting an exception to make these courses fulfill this GE slot?
- o Phrase open option courses thus:
 - Another GE approved course (except Mathematics 1151 or below)
 - GE Cross Disciplinary Seminar
 - Course approved for GE service-learning
 - Course approved for GE education abroad
