The proposal from the School of Music to establish a new undergraduate major program in Music, with three tracks – Computer Sciences, Media and Enterprise, and Sonic Arts – leading to the Bachelor of Science degree, was approved by the Council on Academic Affairs at its meeting on February 3, 2016. Thank you for attending the meeting to respond to questions/comments.

No additional level of internal review/approval is necessary. This action will be included in the Council's next Annual Activities Report to the University Senate (June 2016).

However, given that it is a new major, it will need approval by the Ohio Department of Higher Education and I will submit it for review immediately. Note that you cannot formally offer this major until that level of approval is secured. That should occur before the end of this academic year.
