Dear Kristi and Lindsey,

Today the SBS Panel reviewed two new course proposals for Sociology 4607 and 4650.

I am happy to report that both courses were unanimously approved.

There were a few questions/recommendations for 4650 that I here report:

- Form in curriculum.osu.edu:
 - “A general education quantitative reasoning course or permission of instructor.” It is not clear what is meant by “general education quantitative reasoning.” Does department mean any GE Basic Computation or GE Mathematical or Logical Analysis course? A statistics course? The wording will need to be more specific.
 - Is this a prerequisite only or can it also be a corequisite?
- Syllabus:
 - Add “access to Carmen” under “required texts” section.
 - Add standard statement on academic misconduct and statement about disability services.
 - The schedule mentions a “first midterm” in week 7:2. Since there is only one midterm in the course, it might be best to remove “first” to avoid possible confusion.

Could you please let me know how to change the prerequisite (and corequisite?) information?

Both courses will next advance to the full ASCC for the standard 2-weeks comments period.
