On Thursday, May 29, the ASC Graduate Curriculum Committee reviewed new course proposals for Spanish 5501.10 and 5501.20.

I am pleased to report that both courses were unanimously approved.

The Committee did have a recommendation that in the future syllabi written in a foreign language be either accompanied by a translation in English or a narrative summary of the information in the syllabi.

Also, at the request of the Committee, I have made the following small changes to the course descriptions:

- 5501.10: "AmerIndian language and culture courses offered in study abroad programs (i.e., Guaraní, Aymara). [. . . ]" has become "AmerIndian languages and cultures (e.g., Guarani, Aymara) offered in study abroad programs [. . . ]"
- 5501.20: "Amerindian language and culture courses offered through OSU or another domestic institution (i.e., Guaraní, Aymara). [. . . ]" has become "AmerIndian languages and cultures (e.g., Guarani, Aymara) offered through OSU or another domestic institution [. . . ]"

Both courses will now be advanced to the Graduate School.
