On Friday, April 18, the ASCC Arts and Humanities Panel reviewed a submission for a new course: German 2798.02 (with GE Education Abroad and GE Diversity—Global Studies).

I am happy to report that the course proposal was unanimously approved. The Panel thought it seems like a very interesting course and the course proposal is well put together.

The Panel did have three recommendations, which I here list:

- Could the Department of Germanic Languages and Literatures please notify the Department of History? Some of their students might be interested in taking the course.
- Credit hours calculation potentially misinterprets the credit hours guidelines. Overall, the course seems to be worth much more than the requested 3 semester credit hours.
- Provide updated curriculum map.

The course will next be reviewed by the GE Education Abroad ad-hoc Panel (which handles the review of the GE Education Abroad part).
