Just a note to update you about History 2001H and 2204H (both approved with contingencies by the Honors Panel of the ASCC on 9/15/14). The revisions submitted by the Dept of History were approved by the Chair of the Panel, Professor Dave Stetson. We then transferred the courses to Honors and Scholars and they notified us today that they have approved the courses as well.

Since those are both GE courses (2001H will have GE Historical Study and GE Diversity—Social Diversity in the US and 2204H will have GE Historical Study and GE Diversity—Global Studies), please remember that the GE assessment plans of those courses will need to be implemented each time the courses are offered and GE data gathered. After the second offering of each course, the Department will be asked to submit an initial report summarizing GE assessment results of those first two offerings (following the format of sections I and II of the Assessment Report Requirement in Appendix 6 of the ASC Curriculum and Assessment Operations Manual [p. 75] http://ascas.osu.edu/files/ASC_CurrAssess_Operations_Manual.pdf). Our program assistant Danielle Hogle (hogle.12) can help the Department with any aspect of the GE assessment requirement. She will also make sure to contact the Department before the courses are offered and provide any assistance that the faculty member(s) may need. Could you please communicate this information to the faculty member(s)?
