This note to notify you that Janice Aski (Chair of the Arts and Humanities Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee) has looked over the revisions for Biomedical Sciences Grad Prog 2000 and 2010 and approved the changes.

Since Biomedical Sciences Grad Prog 2000 and 2010 will be new GE courses (with GE Cultures and Ideas), please remember that the GE assessment plans will need to be implemented each time the courses are offered and GE data gathered. After the second offering of each course, the Department will be asked to submit an initial report summarizing GE assessment results of those first two offerings (following the format of sections I and II of the Assessment Report Requirement in Appendix 7 of the ASC Curriculum and Assessment Operations Manual [p. 88] http://asccas.osu.edu/files/ASC_CurrAssess_Operations_Manual.pdf). Our program assistant Danielle Hogle (hogle.12) can help the Department with any aspect of the GE assessment requirement. She will also make sure to contact the Department before the courses are offered and provide any assistance that the faculty members may need. Could you please communicate this information to the faculty members?

I have one specific question: The requested effective term for those course changes is SP15. This is very late since course changes for SP15 needed to have reached the University Registrar's by Sept 1. I see that neither one of the courses will actually be taught this Spring. Could you please let me know whether it is OK for me to change the effective term to SU15? As soon as I hear back from you, I will advance the courses to OAA.
