Dear Matt and Jared,

The revision to Jewish Studies 4798.02 has been approved by Janice Aski, Chair of the Arts and Humanities Panel. However, she does want to point out that the Panel had asked for specifications about what activities are considered “structured educational experiences” because the stated 2.5 hours a day of “structured educational experiences” in-country did not seem to line up with the number of activities planned every day. The response by the faculty member now confirms that the 2.5 hours allotted does not match the actual time spent. All in all, the course as currently designed is likely worth (somewhat) more than the 3 semester credit hours requested.

The course will next be reviewed by the GE Education Abroad ad-hoc Panel for the GE request.
