On Wednesday, December 10th, the ad-hoc GE Education Abroad Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed the GE Education Abroad category request for NELC 2798.01.

The request was ***unanimously approved with one contingency*** and a recommendation.

- Recommendation
 - Use “May session” instead of “May term”
- **Contingency:**
 - Follow the GE Education Abroad assessment plan and submission process found on pages 56-58 of the ASC Curriculum and Assessment Services manual.
