On Friday, November 7, the Arts and Humanities Panel reviewed proposals for two new Chinese courses: Chinese 4301 and 4302.

I am happy to report that the Panel unanimously approved both courses with the small recommendation that for both syllabi the following sentence be removed: "Most of the classes will be ACT classes; all classes will be ACT classes unless indicated on the daily schedules." Indeed, all ACT and FACT classes are already indicated on the daily schedule.
