Professor Whittington and Mollie,

This note to let you know that History of Art 2003H was approved by University Honors and Scholars yesterday and I immediately advanced it to the next step. The course is now moving on to OAA. Provided the course request is subsequently approved all the way through the Office of the University Registrar, History of Art 2003H will be a new course with GE Diversity—Global Studies and GE Visual and Performing Arts starting Spring 2015.

Please know that the GE assessment plans will need to be implemented each time the course is offered and GE data gathered. Could you please remind the faculty member that GE assessment should not be based on course grades. Each individual expected learning outcomes (ELO) for each GE category should be linked to one (or more—but not too many so as not to make the data gathering unwieldy) direct assessment method that directly speaks to each ELO. The use of an indirect assessment method is recommended as well.

After the second offering of the course, the Department will be asked to submit an initial report summarizing GE assessment results of those first two offerings (following the format of sections I and II of the Assessment Report Requirement in Appendix 7 of the ASC Curriculum and Assessment Operations Manual [p. 88] http://asccas.osu.edu/files/ASC_CurrAssess_Operations_Manual.pdf). Our program assistant Danielle Hogle (hogle.12) can help the with any aspect of the GE assessment requirement. Could you please communicate this information to the faculty member?
