Dear Scott,

On Monday, Oct. 5, the Social and Behavioral Sciences Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee re-considered a proposal for new course Anthropology 5700.

The Panel unanimously approved the course with three contingencies and two recommendations:

- Contingencies:
 - Mid-term exam counts for 25% of the grade, but there is no room in the weekly schedule for the mid-term.
 - Please add appropriate weblinks in (1) statement of academic misconduct and (2) disability statement.
 - Include number of contact hours on the syllabus.

- Recommendations:
 - Reference to “quarter” on p. 3 should be replaced by “semester.”
 - Week 15 is a dead week. Might faculty member decide to use this time for another instructional purpose?
