The ASC Graduate Curriculum Committee reviewed Spanish 5389 and Spanish 5705 at their meeting on March 6th.

Spanish 5389 was approved with one *contingency*

- Confer with Anthropology about the title and content of the course and request an updated concurrence.

Spanish 5705 did not go to a vote. The Committee requests that the department address the following concerns:

- Change the course title to reflect that it is a dual career course.
- Adjust the 17 week schedule in the syllabus
- Clarify if this is a Spanish language course or taught in English.
- Clarify the subject matter. For example, all of the syllabi have different topics and the second syllabus title does not seem to align with the topics of the course.
- Suggestion: in the course description add "topics vary."
