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Dear Justin,

On Friday, February 6, the Arts and Humanities Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a new course request for Hebrew 5100.

I am happy to report that the course was unanimously approved with one contingency and one recommendation/question:

- Contingency: If course is an elective in the major, please provide updated curriculum map.
- Recommendation/question: Did Department mean to put “permission of the instructor” as a prerequisite on the form in curriculum.osu.edu? (That is, no student will be able to register without obtaining permission.) Request to remove “graduate standing or permission of the instructor” on the syllabus—indeed, this is a dual career course and so graduate standing cannot be a prerequisite.

I will return the course proposal in a minute to enable the Dept to address the points above.
