## Dear Bernadette,

The Department of Arts Administration, Education \& Policy is adding an informal pathway to our BAE major. We have always had this pathway available to our students but would like to differentiate (in DARS) so that identified students who chose this pathway are not held accountable to fees that may apply to BAE majors seeking licensure. I've enclosed two curriculum sheets so you can see the difference in program plans, but essentially the main difference lies in the final semester when instead of student teaching, an informal BAE major would do a site-specific internship and coursework applicable to community-based art education or museum education. We offer coursework in both areas.

To be clear, this is not a new major. Our BAE degree is separate from licensing as that designation is earned outside of OSU. Each year one or more students realizes they are not interested in public school teaching and they can still complete the BAE major with a few course substitutions. As teacher education programs here at OSU are now subject to stricter guidelines for entry, we feel this will allow us to attract more students to other art education careers outside of schools. Art Education would then have three tracks, the BAE with Licensure, the Informal BAE, and the Licensure-Only post-degree pathway.
