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Dear Shari,

On Friday, February 6, the Arts and Humanities Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a request to revise the Bachelor of Art Education.

I am happy to report that the proposal was unanimously approved by the Panel with one contingency:

Request to provide two clean advising sheets (for both Informal and Licensure) with updated GE information. Academic adviser Ed Quinn should be able to help out updating GE part of both advising sheets. Some aspects seem outdated or incomplete: for example (*not limited to*):

- o "Arts and Humanities" subcategory no longer exists.
- o Reference to "Non-Western" and "Western (non-US) or Non-Western" is both outdated and incorrect.
- o Do students really have to take one biological science course with lab and two physical science courses without lab? Usually there is flexibility as to which science course has a lab and whether a second biological science or second physical science course is to be taken.
- o There where specific course numbers exist, please specify these. For example, isn't the Psychology course "Psychology 1100"?
