Dear Cynthia and Julie,

Yesterday, the GE Education Abroad ad-hoc Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee (ASCC) completed an e-vote on Linguistics 2797.01.

The course was unanimously approved for GE Education Abroad with 2 contingencies, which I here list:

1) an explicit statement in the course proposal that an OSU faculty member will conduct the GE assessment. This will make the OSU faculty involvement explicit, in case there are any questions about this in the future;

and

2) the explicit identification of an end-of-course reflection assignment. The Panel will leave it to the proposers to decide if this should be a new and separate assignment, or if they want to specify that the 4th weekly reflection should consider the entire time in-country. In some way, though, the Panel thinks this proposal has to include a reflection that's explicitly designated as "end-of-course", in order to meet the requirement in the ASC guidelines.

I will return the course in a minute via curriculum.osu.edu to enable the Dept to make the necessary changes.
