Dear Richard,

On Friday, Oct. 2, the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a proposal to make changes to two majors in the Department of Classics: revision to two concentrations in Classics Major & revision to Ancient History and Classics Major.

The proposal was unanimously approved with the contingency to clarify the credit hours for Classics 4999(H)—either an option or a requirement in the revised programs. In the proposal, the course is mentioned as a 4-credit course from now on. However, in SIS (curriculum.osu.edu etc) the course is still variable 1-6 credits. Could you please confirm that the course itself will not be changed—just that there will be an expectation that students will take the course for 4 credits in their major & that if they take more hours of 4999(H) these hours will simply not count in the major.

We will wait for your response.
