Dear Professors Shabel and Goldish,

On Friday, September 18, the Arts and Humanities Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee

reviewed a proposal to add GE Cultures and Ideas to Philosophy / Jewish Studies 3111.

I am happy to report that the addition of the GE was approved with 2 contingencies:

- For Philosophy version: Please, provide complete and updated curriculum map explaining how the course will fit in the major. The document provided is a description of the Philosophy major requirements, not a curriculum map.
- Both versions: GE assessment plan: (1) The direct measures of the GE expected learning outcomes (ELOs) seem difficult to quantify (for example, course grades often are not solely based on meeting the GE ELOs). It might be good to use a rubric. (2) Indirect measures: SEI's do not contain questions pertaining to the GE expected learning outcomes and thus cannot be used for GE assessment.

The faculty Chair of the Arts and Humanities Panel is Janice Aski (aski.1). Should you have any questions about the vote of the Panel, please direct your questions to her.
