Dear Anthony and Richard,

On Friday, October 2, the Arts and Humanities Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a proposal to add GE Cultures and Ideas and GE—Global Studies to Classics 2798.02

As I previously indicated to Anthony, the proposal was unanimously approved.

The Panel did have one small recommendation to remove a sentence on p. 1 of the syllabus about this not being a GE course: "The May travel course is not now being proposed to fulfill a GE category, but may in the future be so enhanced to fulfill the category Cultures and Ideas and Diversity: Global Studies."

I am including the usual reminder that the GE assessment plan for Classics 2798.02 will need to be implemented each time the course is offered and GE data gathered. Like for all new GE courses, after the second offering of the course, the Assessment Panel will ask the Department to submit an initial report summarizing GE assessment results of those first two offerings (following the format of sections I and II of the Assessment Report Requirement in Appendix 8 of the ASC Curriculum and Assessment Operations Manual [p. 116]
