Dear Barry,

On Friday, Oct. 23, the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a proposal to revise the Comparative Studies BA.

The Committee unanimously approved the proposal with two contingencies:

- Include a statement in the proposal specifying if any students are still in the Religious Studies track and if so, what will happen to them now that Religious Studies is a major on its own.
- Comparative Studies 2099 will become a required course for all majors. At this point, the Arts and Humanities Panel has not fully approved the course. The course was approved with one contingency pertaining to the homework/outside readings. The latter did not seem to be sufficient to justify a one credit course. Approval of BA revision is contingent on full approval of CS 2099.
