As is the case for all new GE courses, after the second offering of the course, the Assessment Panel will ask the Department to submit an initial report summarizing GE assessment results of those first two offerings (following the format of sections I and II of the Assessment Report Requirement in Appendix 8 of the ASC Curriculum and Assessment Operations Manual [p. 116]
