Dear Alex,

On Friday, October 2, the Arts and Humanities Panel of the ASCC reviewed proposals to change the credit hours of 5250.01 from 3 fixed to variable 3-4 (as well as change the number from 5250 to 5250.01) and to create a new decimalized number 5250.02 for Dostoevsky (also variable credit 3-4).

The Panel unanimously approved both requests with one contingency and one recommendation:

- Contingency: Panel thinks it is an issue that extra session will not be scheduled as regular class time with the Registrar's office before start of semester. Furthermore, in order to have a course count for 4 credits, this fourth hour would need to be scheduled *every* week (not every other week).
- Recommendation: Define criteria for extra credit. How do students earn extra points? Syllabus mentions 1-3 points for attending two extra sessions but does not clarify how the decision will be made to attribute 1 point or 2 points or 3 points.
