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Dear Justin,

On Monday, October 12, the Arts and Humanities Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed the new course proposal for Uzbek 3102.

I am happy to report that the Panel approved the course with *four recommendations*:

- Modify course goal from “fluency” to ‘proficiency-oriented’ or ‘working towards fluency’.
- Since the course is not a distance learning course, the reference to distance technology as a teaching method on the syllabus should be removed.
- Attendance policy should read “expected to attend every class” instead of course.
- Provide more information about assignments and tests on the syllabus, including the due dates.

The proposal will now be advanced to the next level.
