Dear Scott,

On Monday, Oct. 19, the Social and Behavioral Sciences Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a proposal to revise the Forensic Science Minor.

The proposal was unanimously approved with the following recommendations:

- Three courses in the electives present some issues:
 - CSE 5471 has now become CSE 4471.
 - Entomology 3000 has now become Entomology 4000.
 - Mol Gen 5640 does not exist.
- Under “elective courses”: “The remaining credit hours yielding 15 total hours for the minor may be chosen from the above courses or any of the electives below” Add “at least” before “15 total hours.” Also, suggestion to include information again that those courses that are used to fulfill the core requirements cannot be used as electives. Thus, the revised sentence would read, “The remaining credit hours yielding at least 15 total hours for the minor may be chosen from any of the electives below, excluding those used to complete the core requirements.”

The revision to the Minor will next be reviewed by the full ASC Curriculum Committee at its meeting on Friday. Please let me know if you would like me to make some or all of the changes suggested below to the revised advising sheet that will be discussed at ASCC (i.e., change numbers for CSE 4471 and Entomology 4000; remove Mol Gen 5640(?); replace sentence as described in second bullet point above).
