Dear all,

On Friday, Oct. 30, the Arts and Humanities Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed course proposals for English & Linguistics 5804 (new courses).

As you will recall from the team-teaching cfp (which I am here attaching), courses submitted for the ASC team-teaching grant are first approved as curricular items (i.e., as courses) for inclusion in their departments' curricula. (This step is independent from the grant review, which occurs afterwards.) It is this first step that took place last Friday.

The Arts and Humanities Panel unanimously approved the new course proposals with one contingency and one recommendation:

## <u>Contingency</u>:

• Please request concurrence from School of Communication.

## Recommendations:

• The form in curriculum.osu.edu lists the following campuses: Columbus, Lima, Mansfield, Marion, Newark, and Wooster. This is probably a mistake since both faculty members are not going to go to those regional campuses to teach their course.

Please know that other team-teaching courses were reviewed by the Arts and Humanities Panel last week and some of these need a few revisions. When all the team-teaching courses have come back to us with approved revisions, these will be reviewed by the full ASC Curriculum Committee (ASCC) for possible team-teaching grants. We fully hope this will take place very soon.

I will return the course requests via curriculum.osu.edu in a minute to enable the departments to address the feedback above. Rapid resubmission is highly encouraged so that the full ASC Curriculum Committee can proceed with the grant review.
