Dear Professor Daley,

The Art Department would like to make a slight change to the requirements for the Art Minor.

Currently, there are two curricular requirements for the Art Minor: Art 2000 (Encountering Contemporary Art) and either Art 2100 (Drawing I) or Art 2300 (Visual Studies: 2D). The Art Department would like to remove the requirement that students must take either Art 2100 or Art 2300. Eliminating this requirement, students will have the opportunity to follow their varied research interests. Our more discipline centric students will have the opportunity to take more upper-level courses in their desired discipline.

In addition to the requirement change to the Art Minor, I took the opportunity to reorganize and add courses to the list of electives. With the removal of Art 2100 and 2300 as an Art Minor requirement, I listed Art 2100 under Painting/Drawing. I also created a non-area introduction grouping consisting of Art 2300 Visual Studies: 2D, Art 2400 Visual Studies: 3D, and Art 2500 Visual Studies: Digital Image. Finally, I added five classes that reflect the possible elective possibilities under Photography including Art 5105, Art 5115, Art 5205, Art 5215, Art 5445.
