On Friday, December 4, the Arts and Humanities Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee (ASCC) reviewed a proposal for new course request History 2271 with GE Historical Study and GE Diversity-Global Studies. I am happy to report that the request was unanimously approved.

I am including a reminder that the GE assessment plan will need to be implemented from the very first offering of the course and GE data gathered. As is the case for all new GE courses, after the second offering of the course, the Assessment Panel will ask the Department to submit an initial report summarizing GE assessment results of those first two offerings (following the format of sections I and II of the Assessment Report Requirement in Appendix 8 of the ASC Curriculum and Assessment Operations Manual [p. 116]
