Dear Mary Anne and Ryan,

On behalf of the ASC Curriculum Committee (ASCC), I want to thank you again for coming to the curriculum meeting on Friday, April 1 and answering some questions pertaining to the proposed MIP BA. As you know, the new major was unanimously approved by the ASCC.

At the meeting, some important points were brought up by Assistant Executive Dean May Ellen Jenkins. These are:

- 1) Advising sheet:
 - Art 2555 and History of Art 2901 are both approved for GE. Art 2555 is a GE VPA course and History of Art 2901 is both a GE VPA and GE Diversity-Global Studies course. Therefore, both courses can count in the Open Option GE category.
 - The Open Option language regarding Math is BS language rather than BA language. Instead of “(except Mathematics 1151 or below),” it should state “(except Math 1075 or below).”
- 2) A conversation about who the major advisor will be needs to take place before the major is up and running.

For point 1) that pertains to the advising sheet, I have adjusted your advising sheet based on Mary Ellen’s comments. Please see document attached. If you give me the OK, I will accept my own track changes and include this latest version of the advising sheet in the major program proposal that will be advanced to the Office of Academic Affairs for review by CAA. Please let me know what you think.
