Dear Angela and Derek,

On Monday, April 4, the Social and Behavioral Sciences Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee considered a request for GE Social Science-Individuals and Groups for new course Slavic 3760.

The SBS Panel did not vote on the request. Please find below the feedback of the Panel:

- Course is about relationship between language and society. A lot of the course is historical linguistic. It seems to be a very interesting course. However, it is not suitable for GE Social Science—Individuals and Groups. Indeed, it does not use the theories and methods of social scientific inquiry and does not contain enough social science.
- Another GE category might be a better fit (maybe GE Diversity-Global studies).
