On Tuesday, March 29, the Arts and Humanities Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a proposal for a new freshman seminar "Why Do We Travel?"

I am happy to report that the Panel unanimously approved the new course with two recommendations:

- Top of page 1 of syllabus refers to course being Pass/Fail. This is incorrect. Course will be Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory. This is stated correctly at the bottom of that same page.
- Recommend using the appropriate disability statement: "Students with disabilities that have been certified by the Office for Disability Services will be appropriately accommodated and should inform the instructor as soon as possible of their needs.
