Since January 2014, the following policy has been in place: After the second offering of a newly approved GE course, the Assessment Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee asks the department to submit an initial report summarizing GE assessment results of those first two offerings (following the format of sections I and II of the Assessment Report Requirement in Appendix 8 of the ASC Curriculum and Assessment Operations Manual [p. 116] http://asccas.osu.edu/files/ASC_CurrAssess_Operations_Manual.pdf). Our program assistant Danielle Hogle (hogle.12) can help the Department of Astronomy with any aspect of the GE assessment requirement. She will also make sure to contact the faculty member(s) before the course is offered and provide any assistance that may be needed with assessment.
