On Tuesday, April 12, the Arts and Humanities Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a request to add GE Diversity-Global Studies to History of Art 3901.

The Panel unanimously approved the request with one contingency pertaining to the GE assessment plan, namely:

- The method of assessment selected by the faculty member for expected learning outcome #2 is based on discussion. This appears very challenging to document since that information is neither quantifiable nor easily collectable.
- Third column: There appears to be a misunderstanding about the type of information that needs to be supplied in that column. The process to be explained in that column pertains to the methods of assessment presented in the first column. In the current plan, a process unrelated to the information of column 1 is presented.

I will return History of Art 3901 to the dept queue via curriculum.osu.edu in a minute to enable a revision of the assessment plan.
