On Tuesday, April 26, the Arts and Humanities Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a proposal for a new freshman seminar "High and Low? Art and Popular Culture."

The Panel did not vote on the proposal but would like the following points addressed first:

- Please request concurrences from (1) Film Studies and (2) Department of English (they have a minor in Popular Culture). Contact person for Film Studies is Ryan Friedman (Director; <u>friedman.193@osu.edu</u>) and contact person for English is Debra Moddelmog (Chair; <u>moddelmog.1@osu.edu</u>).
- Panel thinks that the workload for a one-hour freshman seminar is heavy: ten paragraphlong responses and a five-page analytical paper, five movies, five comics, two film screenings and two visits to museums. The guidelines issues by the Ohio Department of Higher Education indicate that for every hour of formalized instruction students should work an average of two hours at out-of-class assignments.
