Dear David and Ashley,

On Tuesday, April 26, the Arts and Humanities Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee (ASCC) reviewed new course proposals for History 2710 and 3670, both with GE Historical Study.

I am happy to report that the courses were unanimously approved with the following suggestions:

- History 2710:
 - Each class should be 1 hr 20 minutes, not 1 hr 15 minutes as currently indicated on the syllabus.
 - Suggest sending fyi about this new course to (1) College of Engineering, (2) Department of Design, (3) Department of Comparative Studies, and (4) Department of Germanic Languages and Literatures. Students in all these areas might be very interested in taking the course.

- History 3670:
 - GE goals and expected learning outcomes are outdated (have not been used since switch to semesters). Please use latest GE goals and expected learning outcomes <http://asccas.osu.edu/curriculum/ge-goals-and-learning-outcomes#Historical%20Study>

As always, I am including a reminder that the GE assessment plan will need to be implemented from the very first offering of the courses and GE data gathered. As is the case for all new GE courses, after the second offering of the courses, the Assessment Panel will ask the Department to submit an initial report summarizing GE assessment results of those first two offerings (following the format of sections I and II of the Assessment Report Requirement in Appendix 8 of the ASC Curriculum and Assessment Operations Manual [p. 116]
