Dear Virginia,

On Tuesday, April 26 , the Arts and Humanities Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a request for new course ASC 2798.05.

I am happy to report that the Panel unanimously approved the course with one contingency and one recommendation:

- Contingency: Request concurrences from (1) the Department of Spanish and Portuguese and (2) the Department of African-American and African Studies.
- Recommendation: Pp. 6-7: The GE assessment plan mixes GE assessment and assessment of effectiveness of teaching. The latter is the case for the passage that starts with "I also intend to ask students to fill out a discursive evaluation of the course that will help me determine what areas in my particular teaching style need improvement...." Teaching style does not pertain to GE expected learning outcomes. Also, OIA would not be the office interested in GE assessment. It is the College of Arts and Sciences that oversees the GE program.

I will return the course to the initiator queue in curriculum.osu.edu so that the feedback above can be addressed. Could you please send the concurrences and/or any revisions to Debbie Hanlin for her to upload in the system?
