

Alison Beach is Associate Professor of History at Ohio State, specializing in the history of the Middle Ages. Her research focuses on religious life in the central Middle Ages (mainly monks and nuns!) and on the interaction between religion and society in the eleventh and twelfth century. She teaches a variety of undergraduate courses at OSU, including Introduction to Medieval History, Medieval History 1, Medieval History 2, Medieval Christianity, and research and readings seminars on monasticism and the material culture of the Middle Ages. She is also the Resident Director of OSU's learning-abroad course, The History and Archaeology of Medieval Ireland: Trim and the Blackfriary, offered each year during the May Summer Session.
