The ASC Curriculum Committee has reviewed your proposal for a new freshman seminar, "How Much is Too Much? Balancing Life in College."

No vote was taken on the proposal. Please find below the faculty feedback:

The syllabus is rather generic and does not provide enough details. The connection between college success skills and principles of economics is not made explicit nor does the textbook seem to convey that perspective either. (As a small reminder, the disability statement should be increased to 16 point font)

Resubmitting a more complete syllabus will enable the Committee to fully consider your proposal. The proposal indicates that you would like to offer the course during Autumn term. In order for that to remain a possibility (to be put on the schedule in time for students to enroll), the Committee encourages you to resubmit your syllabus as soon as possible.
