On Tuesday, September 20, the Arts and Humanities 1 Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee considered a proposal to offer CSFRST 2374 (an existing course with GE Historical Study) 100% on-line.

The Panel did not take a vote on the course but would like clarifications about the following first:

- The Panel does not really understand what is going on in the course. For example:
 - How do students meet the instructor in the distance learning environment? Are there any lectures? Are the discussions synchronous or asynchronous? How do students receive feedback from the instructor?
 - Office hours: Are these in person or virtual or both?
 - How are discussions fostered in the discussion forums and how are the contributions graded?
- How is safety of on-line quizzes and exams guaranteed?
- P. 2 of both syllabi: The term "GEC" has not been used since semester conversion. Please use "GE."

I will return the course via curriculum.osu.edu in a minute to enable the department to address the points above.
