Dear Kynthia,

On Wednesday, October 5, the SBS Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee considered requests to add GE Education Abroad to Public Health 3189.01 and 3189.01E.

The Panel did not take a vote on the requests but would like the following points addressed first:

- GE expected learning outcome #1: “Students recognize and describe similarities, differences, and interconnections between their host country/countries and the U.S.” This comparative aspect is not clearly visible in the syllabus. It is explained in the GE rationale, but the Panel does not see such information in the schedule in the syllabus.
- In the GE assessment plan: Remove reference to SEIs since SEIs are not used for GE assessment. It is also important that the “student achievement data” used in this context pertain to the GE Education Abroad expected learning outcomes (not other course goals / grades).
- The syllabus contains a reference to “GEC” on p. 2. The GEC was replaced by the GE with semester conversion. Please adjust.
- Recommend including readings in schedule in syllabus.

I will return the two courses via curriculum.osu.edu in a minute to enable the College of Public Health to address the points above.
