Dear Rick,

On Wednesday, November 16th, the ASCC SBS Panel reviewed the proposal for Economics 8856. The proposal was approved with the following *contingencies*:

- Update the Disability Services statement
  - The Office of Student Life Disability Services has moved and the College's preferred statement is now, "Students with disabilities (including mental health, chronic or temporary medical conditions) that have been certified by the Office of Student Life Disability Services will be appropriately accommodated and should inform the instructor as soon as possible of their needs. The Office of Student Life Disability Services is located in 098 Baker Hall, 113 W. 12th Avenue; telephone 614-292-3307, [slds@osu.edu](mailto:slds@osu.edu); [slds.osu.edu](http://slds.osu.edu)."
- Clarify which readings are required. It is not clear if the background readings are required or optional. In addition, make it clear for students if they will need to purchase all of the reading materials or if the instructors will provide the materials for them.
- Provide more detail about the assignments in the syllabus.
- Reminder: when the course is taught, include the grading scale on the syllabus.
