On Friday, January 20, the Arts and Humanities 2 Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a proposal for a new seminar "Crash Course in Grammar, Usage, and Research Writing."

I am happy to report that the panel unanimously approved the seminar with two recommendations (when the course is taught):

- In AU 17, "freshman seminars" will be renamed "first-year seminars."
- The Office of Student Life Disability Services has moved and the College's preferred statement is now, "Students with disabilities (including mental health, chronic or temporary medical conditions) that have been certified by the Office of Student Life Disability Services will be appropriately accommodated and should inform the instructor as soon as possible of their needs.
