Terry,

On Tuesday, January 31, the NMS Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a request for Chemistry 1612 (new course).

The Panel did not vote on the proposed new course but would like the following points/questions addressed first:

- How many students will the Dept be ready to accommodate? In AU16 there were 171 students enrolled in Chemistry 1610. Department might need to be ready to offer as many as

20 to 22 peer groups.

- The Dept of Chemistry should make sure that this opportunity is broadly available.
- How will students know about this course and understand that this will be valuable to them?
- How are peer-leaders trained, assessed, and perhaps compensated?
- Update disability services statement. The Office of Student Life Disability Services has moved and the College's preferred statement is now, "Students with disabilities (including mental health, chronic or temporary medical conditions) that have been certified by the Office of Student Life Disability Services will be appropriately accommodated and should inform the instructor as soon as possible of their needs.
