On Friday, January 20, the Arts and Humanities 2 Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee considered proposals for two new ASL courses: ASL 2104 and 3105.

The Panel unanimously approved the courses with two recommendations:

- For ASL 2104: The Office of Student Life Disability Services has moved and the College's preferred statement is now, "Students with disabilities (including mental health, chronic or temporary medical conditions) that have been certified by the Office of Student Life Disability Services will be appropriately accommodated and should inform the instructor as soon as possible of their needs. The Office of Student Life Disability Services is located in 098 Baker Hall, 113 W. 12th Avenue; telephone 614-292-3307, slds@osu.edu; slds.osu.edu."
- Both courses will only be offered on the Columbus campus. Would the ASL program consider approving these for the regional campuses as well since a minor is being developed and ASL 1101-1103 is available on the regionals? Students on regional campuses will likely be very interested in this minor.
