On Friday, January 20, the Arts and Humanities 2 Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee considered a proposal to add GE Diversity-Social Diversity in the U.S. to Religious Studies 3678.

The Panel unanimously approved the course with one contingency about the GE assessment plan and two recommendations:

• Contingency: GE assessment plan:

- For each assessment method you will use, please provide specific examples of questions.
- For the longer paper assignments, "rubrics" are mentioned. Please provide sample rubric.
- How will you assess "semester-long" discussion? How will faculty member be able to assess discussion throughout the semester? More focused assessment method would be preferable.

• Recommendations:
