Last Friday, the Arts and Humanities 1 Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee considered a proposal for Pharmacy 3420 (new course with GE Cultures and Ideas to be offered 100% online).

The Panel was very much impressed by the course proposal. It is a thoroughly well-put together GE and distance learning proposal— actually, one of the finest ever reviewed by the ASC Curriculum Committee.

The Panel did have one question, namely: What is the expected course enrollment and how will a possible large enrollment be managed? Could you please let us know?

I am including the usual reminder that the GE assessment plan will need to be implemented from the very first offering of the course and GE data gathered. As is the case for all new GE courses, after the second offering of the course, the Assessment Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee will ask the College of Pharmacy to submit an initial report summarizing GE assessment results of those first two offerings (following the format of sections I and II of the Assessment Report Requirement in Appendix 9 of the ASC Curriculum and Assessment Operations Manual [p. 121] [https://asccas.osu.edu/sites/asccas.osu.edu/files/ASC\\_CurrAssess\\_Operations\\_Manual.pdf](https://asccas.osu.edu/sites/asccas.osu.edu/files/ASC_CurrAssess_Operations_Manual.pdf) ). The Assessment Panel and/or our office can help the department with any aspect of the GE assessment requirement. We will also make sure to contact the department before the course is offered and provide any assistance that may be needed with assessment.
