Dear Professor Anderson,

On Tuesday, February 28, the Natural and Mathematical Sciences (NMS) Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed your proposal for a new First-Year Seminar, "STEM Outreach to K12 Students."

I am happy to report that the Panel unanimously approved the seminar with two recommendations (for when the course is taught):

- The College of ASC's preferred disability statement is, "Students with disabilities (including mental health, chronic or temporary medical conditions) that have been certified by the Office of Student Life Disability Services will be appropriately accommodated and should inform the instructor as soon as possible of their needs. The Office of Student Life Disability Services is located in 098 Baker Hall, 113 W. 12th Avenue; telephone 614-292-3307, slds@osu.edu; slds.osu.edu."
- The full statement on academic misconduct is: "It is the responsibility of the Committee on Academic Misconduct to investigate or establish procedures for the investigation of all reported cases of student academic misconduct. The term "academic misconduct" includes all forms of student academic misconduct wherever committed; illustrated by, but not limited to, cases of plagiarism and dishonest practices in connection with examinations. Instructors shall report all instances of alleged academic misconduct to the committee (Faculty Rule 3335-5-487).
