On Monday, March 20, the SBS Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee considered a new course request for Psychology 5603.

The Panel approved the course with three contingencies and four comments/questions:

- Contingencies:
  - How will student presentations be assessed?
  - Describe how student participation will be evaluated.
  - Page one of both syllabi states, “Students will select a primary research article from a list curated by the instructor.” Provide the list of primary research articles.
  
- Comments/Questions:
  - What topics are covered in weeks 11-14?
  - How many times will students present?
  - The panel feels the assessment is light for the undergraduate portion of the course, especially quizzes (each one only being 5 minutes).
  - The panel recommends adding the learning objectives to the syllabus.

I will return Psychology 5603 via curriculum.osu.edu to enable the dept to address the points above.
