Dear Professor Thomas,

On Wednesday, March 29, the Arts and Humanities 1 Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee considered a proposal for the following dual graduate degrees: MA WGSS & MA JGC / MA WGSS & MPA JGC.

The Panel unanimously approved the course with three contingencies, namely:

- Where will students get advising to make sure the courses are coherently chosen in WGSS?
- Provide a rationale as to why most of the Dual Credit courses in section C are from JGC. What is the rationale for the unequal distribution of credits?
- Panel is assuming that units spoke with representatives of the Graduate School but would like clarification on how some decisions were made. For example, what is the rule that says the Dual Credit courses must equal 50% of the larger degree?

After clearing the Arts and Humanities 1 Panel, the proposal will need to go to the full ASC Curriculum Committee (and will then move on to the Graduate School). There is only one meeting of the ASC Curriculum Committee left this term (and the Committee does not meet over the Summer). To ensure that your proposal is added to the agenda of the last meeting, we encourage you to provide responses to the three questions as soon as possible. (I would suggest this week or Monday of next week at the latest.)
